On the Duty of Civil Disobedience, called Civil Disobedience for short, is an essay by American transcendentalist Henry David

Thoreau that was first published in 1849. In it, Thoreau argues that individuals should not permit governments to overrule or atrophy their consciences, and that they have a duty to avoid allowing such acquiescence to enable the government to make them the agents of injustice. Thoreau was motivated in part by his disgust with slavery and the Mexican-American War (1846-1848). mere 4,435 words long - and set out the absolute bare minimum requirements for the world's first modern democracy: separation of powers between the President, Congress, the Senate, and the Judicial system; and a procedure for adding amendments. Over the next 200 years, 27 of these were added - most of them a single sentence in length. But while the legal backbone of our country is still very succinct, the reality of our political, judicial and economic system is anything but. After 25 chapters, Joyce abandoned *Stephen Hero* in 1907 and set to reworking its themes and protagonist into a condensed five-chapter novel, dispensing with strict realism and making extensive use of free indirect speech that allows the reader to peer into Stephen's developing consciousness. James Joyce (1882-1941) was an Irish novelist and poet, considered to be one of the most influential writers in the modernist avant-garde of the

early 20th century. Joyce is best known for *Ulysses*, a landmark work in which the episodes of Homer's *Odyssey* are paralleled in an array of contrasting literary styles, perhaps most prominent among these the stream of consciousness technique he utilized.
